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<u>Food \$en\$e</u>

Food \$en\$e is a monthly food buying co-op for anyone who wants to stretch their grocery dollars. Monthly Package- \$20.50 A sample food box includes:

- 4-5 meat items like chicken, ground beef, and fish
- 4-5 staple items like pasta and rice
- 4-5 fresh produce items like carrots or oranges

Monthly specials like stuffed pork chops, American cheese, meatballs, and chicken tenders can be purchased in addition to the box.

Mobile Food Pantry

The Mobile Pantry of CNY Food Bank comes to Camden! There is no income guidelines for families to receive food. While supplies last. Please note: To allow for other scheduled events and Pantry set up, you will not be able to line up for the Mobile Pantry before 2pm. January's Pantry date is: Thursday, February 23 at 3pm.

Camden Area Food Pantry

The Camden Area Food Pantry continues to operate on an appointment-only basis. To make an appointment, call **315-335-4615**. Calls will be returned during normal pantry hours: Tuesday & Thursday: 10am-12:30pm. People wishing to make donations of food or non-food items should call the above number and make an appointment to take your donations.

Why all this conversation about food resources?

If you have ventured into a grocery store in recent weeks, you can't help but notice the increased cost of ALL the things. Additionally, Emergency SNAP will be ending at the end of February.

Since March 2020, Congress temporarily increased SNAP benefits because of the COVID-19 public health emergency. Supplemental EA SNAP benefits were issued to households in addition to their normal monthly SNAP benefit amount. As a result, households received more SNAP benefits each month than they would have normally been eligible for based on their income and expenses.

Congress passed the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 in December 2022 that ended the supplemental EA benefits. February 2023 is the last month that supplemental EA benefits will be issued, and your SNAP benefits will return to the normal amount in March 2023.
